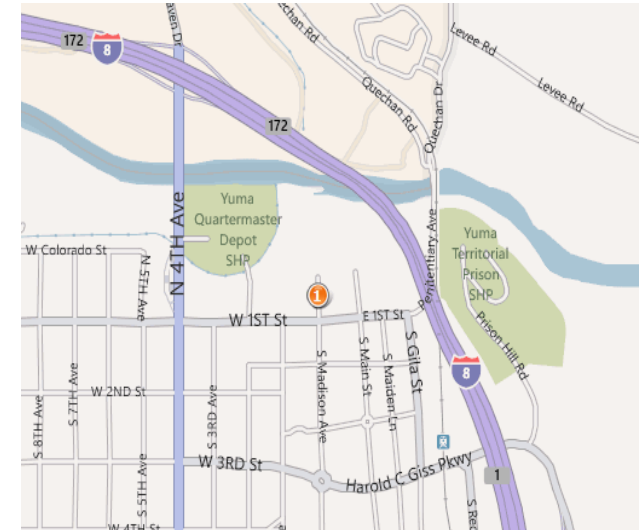

From I-8, San Diego to Yuma, exit @ #172 “Fourth Ave” (Business Loop 8), on California side of Colorado River.

From I-8, Yuma to San Diego, exit @ #172 “Fourth Ave” (Business Loop 8), on California side of Colorado River.

Drive south on Fourth Ave. Enter AZ side of river by crossing over bridge. Turn left at first light (1st Street), left to Madison Avenue, & left into parking area.

WHY DO I HAVE TO PAY?

Some members have asked why A.A.s and Al-Anons have to pay a fee to attend a conference, convention or other special event. A.A. and Al-Anon membership is free, and meetings and most A.A. and Al-Anon events are self-supporting in the spirit of the Seventh Tradition. However, A.A. and Al-Anon gatherings beyond the group meeting level, like the 7th Annual International SIS Conference, require months of planning, preparation and deposits presented upfront to the hotel and other business facilities involved.

Additional expenses include the printing of flyers, schedules, postage and supplies, renting meeting space, insurance coverage, and travel and accommodations for the invited speakers.

All expenses for our conference are paid through registration; we don't collect 7th tradition at A.A. or Al-Anon meetings held during the event. In the spirit of that tradition, all who participate pay their own way. Our goal is to break even with surplus passed on to next year's host. Thanks!
